(...your only son!)

B. A Repeated Obedience
(...twice God directed - in two opposite directions!)

C. An Instant Obedience
(...early the next day!)

D. A Steadfast Obedience
(...the third day!)

E. A Confident Obedience
(...God will provide for Himself!)
